COVID measures - New Chamber Opera performance, New College

What COVID measures are you introducing?

The event has been risk assessed by New College's Risk Assessor. We have implemented measures in line with Government guidance which we ask you to review and observe during your visit.

Ensure you are feeling well (1). If you are presenting any symptoms of COVID-19, do not attend the performance and follow NHS guidance.

Ensure you are feeling well (2). In light of the prevalence of the Delta variant, New College is currently requiring evidence, to be shown to the front of house staff, of full vaccination (first and second dose), and with the second dose administered at least 14 days before your visit, or of a negative Lateral Flow Test (LFD) within 24 hours of the event through a confirmatory text message from either the NHS or EAS.

Ensure you are feeling well (3). Please use your phone on the QR codes in Cloisters.

E-Tickets. You should currently have e-tickets received via email. When you arrive, please go to the Box Office under the arch to New College Lane where you can collect your numbered tickets and purchase a programme.

Bring your face covering / mask. It is a requirement to wear a mask when inside during your visit, unless you are exempt. We *recommend* you wear them in the venues and when moving around the Cloisters, but as the event is taking place entirely outdoors, you are *not required* to wear them.

Keep a safe distance. Please maintain social distancing at all times with those not in your party to ensure the safety of yourself and others.

Cash Free. This season we are a cash-free site: payment for programmes will be taken by card machines only.

Clean. We have reduced contact points and provided hand sanitiser and enhanced cleaning.

How will picnicking work? Tables will be appropriately distanced in the Cloisters. We have increased the spaces between tables which, in combination with smaller audiences, will ensure everyone can enjoy their evening in comfort and safety.
