Austin, originally from Aotearoa/NZ and Australia, is currently studying a BA in English at the Queen's College. He performs regularly in Australia with groups like the Australian Brandenburg Orchestra and the Evergreen Ensemble. In Oxford, he has sung with the Oxford Bach Soloists as a choral scholar, the choir of Queen's College, and Schola Cantorum. Recent solo performances have include Bach's solo cantata, BWV 169 'Gott Soll Allein Mein Herze Haben', Handel's Dixit Dominus, and a series of recitals centred around the music of Italian castrato Giusto Tenducci. Austin trains with Dermot Tutty in Naarm/Melbourne and is fortunate to have worked in masterclasses with Emma Kirkby, Paul Dyer, and James Conlon.
