



Theo Peters is a London-based tenor who currently sings as an Academical Clerk in the New College Choir, Oxford, studying under Bronwen Mills. The choir recently toured to the US, including Dallas, North Carolina and New York. For 5 years Theo sang in the chapel choir at Eton College, learning with Brian Gordon, and in his last year he was Keeper of the Choir.
